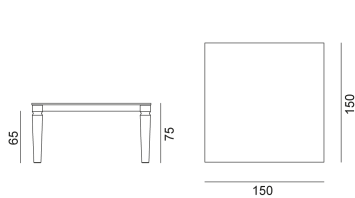

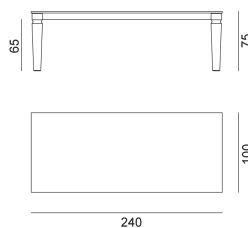

Family of tables with a square or rectangular shape in colonial style of exotic inspiration, Jeko 31/33/34 have legs and a structure made of ECOTEak, a material coming from the reuse of recovered beams and teak elements that have been repaired with recycled wood, assembled and polished to highlight the original veins. They are embellished with top in white Carrara marble or concrete in the Pearl color, so as to create a product that plays on the visual contrasts of the two different materials.

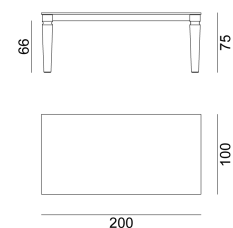
